A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF CHANDLER FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024

WHEREAS, by virtue of Section 1-10-1 of the Chandler City Code, the City Council of the City of Chandler, Oklahoma is authorized to amend fees and charges fixed thereby by resolution;

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to amend certain fees, rates and charges set forth in the City of Chandler Fee Schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER, OKLAHOMA:
