- **II.** Consent Agenda Motion was made by Crouch, seconded by Wilson to approve the consent agenda. Crouch-yea, Wilson-yea, Evans-yea, Young-yea, Imel-yea. Motion carried.

Bass Property Public Hearing opened at 5:11 p.m. Brad Reed on behalf of Joe Bass proposed to the council that they would like to rezone the 70 acres for a housing addition. Approximately 240 new homes to be built. Lots will be 6,000 sq ft. Six to eight options of floor plans. Public Hearing ended at 5:28 p.m.
