- I. Call to Order/Roll Call/Establish Quorum** – Mayor Gene Imel called the Chandler City Council Meeting to order at 4:32 p.m. Members present: Gene Imel, Robin Crouch, Rick Evans, Johnny Melton, Virgil Wilson. Members absent: None

- III. Citizens to be Heard - Five (5) Minute Limit Per Person** – There were no citizens to be heard.
- IV. Discussion on location for placement of 40 yard trash receptacles** – City Manager, James Melson explained Republic Services furnish two free waste receptacle per month, but charges for each receptacle as they are picked up and dumped. There would be the issue of staffing and a budget amendment would need to be done for the additional payroll expense. Marlon Miller, District 2 Commissioner, stated Lincoln County is checking on leasing one and one-half acres. The property is a school land lease. Crouch inquired about the lease price that has not been determined at this date. Lincoln County would help with the land preparation for the waste receptacles. Councilmember, Johnny Melton discussed an amendment to the Republic Contract to allow for large trash day pickups, and also suggested inviting Republic Services to the next City Council meeting. Attorney, Larry Lenora inquired about proof of residency to use the service, and that the service would not be free of charge.
